5. Drug & Substance abuse issues may be highlighted by inviting Specialists & Counsellors to address the students.
6. Necessary Student & Teacher Committees may be constituted to tackle the issue of Substances Abuse in the institutions on the lines of Anti-Ragging Committees.
7. All the Professional Colleges and Managements are directed to initiate necessary steps on a Campaign Mode in this regard.

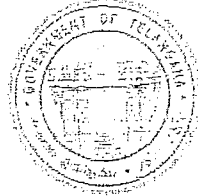

I am to enclose herewith a copy of the reference cited. You are requested to communicate similar advice to the Vice-Chancellors of the five Universities located in Hyderabad i.e., Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad, Jawaharlal Nehru Architecture and Fine Arts University, Hyderabad, Osmania University, Hyderabad, Potti Sreeramulu Telugu University, Hyderabad and Dr.B.R. Ambedkar Open University, Hyderabad, under the administrative control of the Higher Education Department, to take the following steps with regard to the eradication of the Drug Menace:-

1. The Universities must inform their affiliated Colleges Managements and in their University / Constituent Colleges to 'sensitise' their Lecturers and Students about the issue of substance abuse.
2. The areas in the vicinity of the University / College premises must be monitored, especially the nearby shops, addas, etc.
3. Easy availability of cash/debit (or) credit cards with the students may be monitored.
4. Initiate any other appropriate measures that may be required in this regard.

5. Drug & Substance abuse issues may be highlighted by inviting Specialists & Counsellors to address the students.
6. Necessary Student & Teacher Committees may be constituted to tackle the issue of Substance Abuse in the Institutions on the lines of Anti-Ragging Committees.
7. All the Professional Educational Institutions / Managements may be directed to initiate necessary steps on a Campaign Mode in this regard.
2. If the Universities need any assistance (or) support, they may contact the Commissioner, Prohibition & Excise Department, T.S., Hyderabad (or) Sri. Akun Sabarwal, IPS, Director of Enforcement-Prohibition and Excise, Hyderabad.

You are aware that the Excise Department has launched an all out eradication effort with regard to the Drug Menace in Hyderabad and the Telangana Excise STF has arrested (15) persons in connection with Possession & Sale of certain high-end narcotics like LSD, MDMA & Cocaine.

Investigation into the matter is currently on and has revealed certain disturbing facts involving student community in particular. You would agree that prevention of substance abuse is of prime importance and therefore, I request you to initiate the following steps pertaining to your department.

3. Easy availability of cash/debit (or) credit cards with college students may be monitored.
4. To initiate any other appropriate measure that may be required.
5. Drug & Substance abuse issues may be highlighted by inviting specialists & counselors to address the students.
6. Necessary Student & Lecturer Committees may be constituted to grapple with the Substance Abuse in the institutions on the lines of Anti-Ragging.

All the concerned educational institutions/managements may be directed to initiate necessary steps on a campaign mode.
