The undersigned is directed to forward herewith a copy of Joint Secretary, D/o EPwD's DO letter No. 16-26/2016-DD-1 dated 02.06.2016 regarding above mentioned subject Wherein JS, D/o EPwD has informed that under the provision of PWD Act, 1995, M. O SJ&E has been implementing a scheme namely SIPDA for providing financial assistance for undertaking various activities for PWDs.

2. In this regard, D. O EPwD invited proposals for providing financial assistance under the SIPDA Scheme, it is also informed that as per the provision of the SIPDA Scheme, for release of grant-in-aid, the recommendations of the M. O HRD is necessary. It is also requested to send the proposals latest by 31-7-2016 so as to facilitate release of financial assistance in the current financial year.

3. In continuation to this D. O EPwD requested to appraise the organizations for sending their proposals in respect of construction works for creation of barrier free environment in the existing buildings, alongwith the cost estimates duly prepared/approved by an officer not below an Executive Engineer of the CPWD, PWD or any Govt. Agency of the Government. Similarly, they may also be informed to send the proposals relating to accessible websites alongwith the cost estimates duly prepared approved by NIC or any Govt. Agency and these organizations should send a certificate also alongwith their proposals to the effect that they have not received and shall also not receive, any grant from some other Department, Agency of the Govt. for the purpose for which the Grant-in-aid under the SIPDA Scheme is being sought.

4. In this regard, it is requested to all concerned Bureau Heads to send the proposals directly to D/O EPwD.

Dear Shri Sandhu,

The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 ("the PwD Act") casts certain obligations on the appropriate government to provide certain facilities and services to Persons with Disabilities (PwDs). In consonance with the provisions of the Act, this Ministry has been implementing a Scheme of providing financial assistance for undertaking various activities for PwDs. The scheme is known as the "Scheme for Implementation of Persons with disabilities Act, 1995 (SIPDA)". A copy of the SIPDA Scheme is available on the website of this Deptt. Assistance under the Scheme is provided for non-recurring purposes.

2. Under the Scheme, the following activities are covered for financial assistance:

- i) For making buildings barrier-free for PwDs : up to Rs.50.00 lakh per buildings;
- ii) For making accessible website for PwDs : up to Rs.20.00 lakh per website.

3. Therefore, we would like to invite proposals from (i) UGC, (ii) Central Universities and (iii) Autonomous Organizations set up under your Department, for providing financial assistance under the SIPDA Scheme for the aforesaid activities, to fulfill the above mentioned obligations.

4. I would like to inform you that as per the provisions of the SIPDA Scheme, for release of grant-in-aid, the recommendations of the Ministry of HRD is necessary. Therefore, I would be grateful if you could please advise the concerned authorities of above mentioned Organisations, etc. to send the requisite proposals, complete in all respects, to your Department, so that these proposals are examined with regard to their status and eligibility for GIA, before forwarding these proposals to this Department with the recommendations of the Ministry of HRD.


5. It would be appropriate if these proposals are sent to this Department latest by 31st July, 2016, so as to facilitate release of financial assistance in the current financial year itself. In this connection, I would request you to apprise the above Organisations for sending their proposal in respect of construction works for

creation of barrier free environment in the existing buildings, alongwith the cost estimates duly prepared/approved by an officer not below an Executive Engineer of the CPWD/PWD or any Govt. Agency of the Government. Similarly, they may also be informed to send the proposals relating to accessible websites alongwith the cost estimates duly prepared/approved by NIC or any Govt. Agency.

6. I shall feel obliged if you could also advise the above organisations to send a certificate also alongwith their proposals to the effect that they have not received and shall also not receive, any grant from some other Department/Agency of the Govt. for the purpose for which the grant-in-aid under the SIPDA Scheme is being sought.
