

## **NRI (Non-Resident Indians) and Their Academic Eligibility**

NRI (Non-Resident Indians) are Indian Citizens who live in another country. An Indian citizen residing outside India for a combined total of at least 183 days in a financial year (from April 1 to March 31).

1. Non-Resident Indian students are the Indian Nationals studying abroad.
2. They must have had at least 3 (three) years of education in any Foreign country during the last 6 (six) years and must pass the qualifying examination (inclusive of 11th and 12th standard or equivalent) from abroad only.
3. All the NRI students (fourth table consisting of ten students in the updated provisional list), who will appear for the Final Admission Process in JNTUH, should bring study certificate stating that they have passed their 11th and 12th standard (or equivalent) from abroad only.
