1. Hackathon Process

- 1. Interested Faculty members sign up as Jury panelists using the link provided in the 'JNTUH Jury Invitation' mailer
- Interested colleges sign up as participating college in the 'JNTUH SPOC invitation' mailer
- 3. After the SPOCs from colleges sign up as above, they will be intimated about the theme, hackathon topic and other details
- 4. Then their students can register on the online platform
- 5. Students from any branch or discipline are allowed to participate
- 6. Students from 2nd and 3rd year also can participate if they are interested
- 7. Students can form their teams online, after they register
- 8. Students work within their teams and then submit prototypes for Jury evaluation
- 9. The JNTUH Faculty Jury members and other online Jury panelists will evaluate the submitted projects and post their judgment online
- 10. Webinars will be conducted for Jury members, SPOCs and students to explain about the online hackathon process
- 11. An induction webinar for SPOC's of all registered collegeswill be conducted on 22-9-2020
- 12. Hackathon will be launched online on 24-9-2020
- 13. A mentoring session of a Livestream Webinar on Design Thinking by a UI/UX Expert will be conducted on 27-9-2020
- 14. Continuous mentoring will be provided online to all participating students all throughout the hackathon competition period
- 15. Prize distribution and announcement by Vice-Chancellor 14-10-2020
