Military College of Electronics and Mechanical Engineering (MCEME), Secunderabad is a premier technical training institute of Indian Army and is successfully conducting Bachelor of Technology Courses in the field of Mechanical and Electronics Engineering. Training of Gentlemen Cadets (GCs) from Technical Entry Scheme is also conducted at Cadet Training Wing (CTW), MCEME since 2000. B.Tech. Degree is awarded to the GCs on successful completion of training and commissioned as lieutenant in Indian Army.

Since 2000, CTW has been imparting effective Engineering as well as Military training to GCs of 10+2 Technical Entry Scheme, prior to being commissioned into the Indian Army as officers. These GCs undergo stringent selection process at various Service Selection Board (SSB) and undergo one-year Basic Military Training (BMT) at Officers Training Academy, Gaya before joining the B.Tech. programme at CTW, MCEME. During the B.Tech. programme, cadets further undergo three years of rigorous training regime which includes both Engineering and Military training. During the course of training sometimes the GCs suffer injuries/medical condition which render them to be withdrawn on medical grounds, as they are not capable of undergoing the rigors of Indian Army life. This leads to a double blow to the GCs who lose an opportunity of a career in the Army, while they also have to now pursue their further studies in civil institutions, afresh.

In view of the above, and their representation the Commissioner of Technical Education (CTE), Hyderabad (ref. 2) has requested JNTUH to examine the proposal submitted by the Colonel General Staff for Commandant, MCEME for transfer of Gentle man Cadets (GCs) withdrawn on medical/outdoor training (ODT) Grounds into Affiliated and Autonomous Colleges of JNTUH.

Based on their request, the University examined the above proposal and informed to CTE, Hyderabad stating that MCEME has to follow the procedure for transfer of Gentlemen Cadets (GCs) who are withdrawn on Medical/Outdoor Training Ground into B.Tech. courses (vide ref. 4th cited) to continue from that year/semester onwards.

Therefore, all the Directors/Principals of Affiliated and Autonomous Colleges of JNTUH are requested to give First priority to Indian Army for transfer of Gentle Man Cadets (GCs) in the respective Colleges, based on the representation for admission into the B.Tech. courses under transfer students category into your College and following the transfer policy.
