Item No. 02/16 _SC_Sep-2024 To consider and approve for the establishment of alternate source of energy and energy conservation.

In the NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), under Quantitative Metric's of Metric No. 7.1.2., the institute needs to have the following facilities for alternate source of energy and energy conservation.

- 1. Solar energy

- 3. Wheeling to the Grid
- 4. Sensor-based Energy Conservation
- 5. Use of LED bulbs / power efficient equipment.

University is fully equipped with the Use of LED bulbs / power efficient equipment. However, remaining all the other 4 items does not exist. Necessary approval may be given to the concerned Directorate to establish at the earliest in the University Campus.

In the NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), under Quantitative Metric's of Metric No. 1.4.1., the institute needs to develop the feedback system for the following:-

The Principal's of the JNTUH UCESTH & JNTUH UCMH may implement structured feedback for design and review of syllabus – semester wise / year wise is received from 1. Students, 2. Teachers, 3. Employers, 4. Alumni, 5. Parents. The collected feedback need to analyze, action taken and to keep the feedback in the website, this procedure need to be strengthen and establish. This is the mandatory requirement as per the Quantitative Metric's of 1.4.2., under Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), of NAAC. Necessary directions may be given.

To review the number of days from the date of last semester-end/ year- end examination till the declaration of results during the year.

As per the SSR submitted to the NAAC during the academic years 2017-18 to 2021-22, it was observed the results declarations are taking around 30 days. As a standard practices results have to declare within 15 day from the last day of exam. The Principal's of the JNTUH UCESTH & JNTUH UCMH may give their opinion/comments.

Resolution:- The IQAC Steering Committee recommended to publish the results within 15 days from the last day of exam.

Item No. 07/16_SC_Sep-2024 To consider and approve Seed Money to Faculty for research.

In the NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), under Quantitative Metric's of Metric No. 3.1.2., the institute needs to provide seed money to faculty for their Research, Development and Innovation (RDI) & Intellectual Property Rights (IPR). A committee may be constituted to develop modalities for seed money to the Faculty to their Research, Development and Innovation (RDI) & Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

Resolution:- The Steering Committee resolved to have a Committee to develop modalities for seed money to the Faculty to their Research.

Item No. 08/16_SC_Sep-2024 To consider and establish chairs in the University.

In the NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), under Quantitative Metric's of Metric No. 3.2.1., "Extramural funding for Research Grants sponsored by the non-government sources such as industry, corporate houses, international bodies for research projects) endowments, Chairs". The committee may advise to the respected Principal's of the JNTUH UCESTH & JNTUH UCMH to establish a minimum of one chair per each department/centre.

Resolution:- Steering Committee resolved the following:-

- 1. To conduct endowment lectures in each department.
- 2. Chairs shall establish in each department.
- 3. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) shall provide information and procedure for the establishment of Chairs.

Item No. 09/16_SC_Sep-2024

To discuss, consider and approve to issue appreciation letters and cash award for the faculty who received grants for research projects sponsored by the Government Agencies.

In the NAAC Revised Accreditation Framework Process (RAF), under Quantitative Metric's of Metric No. 3.2.2., faculty is getting huge number of projects sponsored by various State & Central government agencies for a tune of more than 500 lakhs in each academic year as per the Self Study Report (SSR). To sustain this tempo, faculty needs to encourage. The committee may consider to issue an appreciation letter to all the faculty who secured research projects from the State & Central Governments. Appreciation letter may be issued through Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) with the approval of University authorities. Further, a committee may be constituted to develop the methodology for issue of cash award for those faculties who received research projects from State & Central government.

- **Resolution:-** 1. The IQAC Steering Committee has resolved to issue appreciation letters to the faculty who received grants for research projects.
 - 2. A Committee may be constituted to develop modalities and to take approval in the Executive Committee of JNTUH for cash rewards.

To discuss and advise about filling of SSR for reassessment for the academic years 2018-19 to 2022-23.

JNTUH University accredited with CGPA of 3.32 on 4 point scale at A+ grade valid from 22nd February,2024 to 21st February, 2029. University needs to achieve CGPA of 3.51 to get accredited A++ grade. NAAC proposed launching of reforms in two phases of Binary Accreditation and Maturity Based Graded Levels (MBGL) with effect from 1st July, 2024 (vide announcement of NAAC reforms of 2024 dated 29th June,2024). In the notification, it was decided to accept Institutional Information of Quality Assessment (IIQA) applications under present methodology Revised Accreditation Frame work (RAF) until 30th June, 2024 (6.00 PM). As last date for submission of Institutional Information of Quality Assessment (IIQA) is 30th June, 2024, as time is over, permission may be accorded to write a letter to the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) to consider our request for filing IIQA.

Resolution:- The IQAC Steering Committee unanimously accepted and approved to apply for new Maturity Based Graded Levels (MBGL) accreditation of National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC).
