





The IQAC Coordinator welcomed all the members to the meeting.

- The Chairman appraised various initiatives of the University.
- The Director, Academic & Planning informed the Committee that meetings with regard to Joint Boards of Studies have been conducted for PG syllabi revision from the Academic Year 2017-18. The IQAC placed on the record the efforts made by the Director, Academic & Planning in taking the task of syllabi revision of PG programs in all affiliated colleges.
- Dr. N.V. Ramana Rao, Rector & the Chairman, IQAC informed that he had attended a meeting at New Delhi on 'Digital Initiatives' during 6-7 July 2017 and

informed that our University should take up the initiative in digitalization of various activities for better functioning.

- It is also informed that National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Ranking and NAAC accreditation are mandatory for getting funds for various projects from funding agencies.
- Henceforth the Committee felt that Joint Meeting to all faculty members of Constituent colleges may be arranged to motivate them and to appraise the NIRF ranking criteria in the areas where improvement need to be done should be identified in order to involve the faculty for improving the NIRF ranking.
- The Joint Boards of Studies meetings were conducted for revision of curriculum syllabi with major changes like PG Seminar 1, which should be industry oriented and to be taken up by the students by visiting the industry Seminar 2 includes the study through website and the students have to submit a study report.
- The anti-plagiarism check has to be introduced additionally at PG level also in addition to the existing Ph.D. level. Members suggested that the interaction with industries may be increased to identify the problems of industry and the same may be taken up as thesis works at PG/Ph.D. level.
- Faculty Development Programs (FDP) in each branch should be encouraged apart from UGC GYAN to be included in NAAC.
- Student Best Projects may be judged by IQAC for awards.
- Research methodology is to be made compulsory for PG students.
- All Service Registers of employees (Teaching and Non-Teaching) should be digitalized.
- All text books in the University may be digitalized.
- Finance department activities are to be digitalized.
- All affiliated colleges have to pay the fee to the University only **in digital mode**.
- A Committee may be constituted to look after the library activities for the Library instead of Professor I/c of Library.
- The IQAC members advised to hold meeting at-least once in a month to discuss all the aspects from time to time.
