2.1 Conduct of XI Convocation on 18th March 2023.

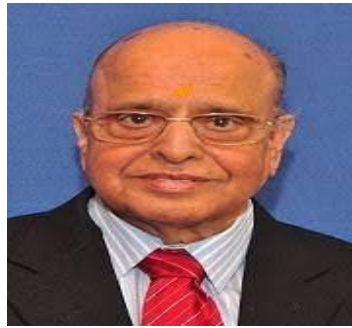

A workshop was conducted on 9th February 2023 titled “Results Processing - Affiliated Autonomous Engineering Colleges of JNTUH, Hyderabad”.

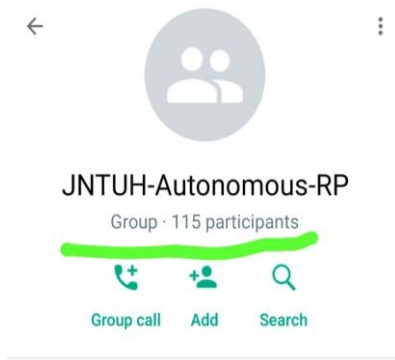

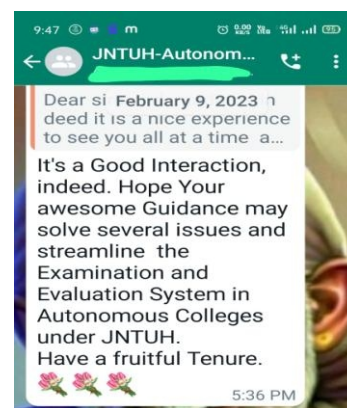

Based on the academic calendar, the Directorate of University Examinations, JNTUH develops a timeline sheet semester wise for each course and it will be followed to achieve the vision of the Directorate of University Examinations.

2.5 Allotment of Examination Centers for Affiliated College Students

Students are jumbled cluster wise and mapped to host colleges for writing university end semester examinations, without giving an undue advantage to the students. Cluster based jumbling process is done with automation using software developed in-house. In this academic year, 272639 students were appeared for UG Examinations in 605 host centers monitored by 600 observers from cluster colleges and more than 130 special observers from the university. Similarly, in the current academic year, 20055 students were appeared for PG examinations in 201 host centers monitored by 220 observers from cluster colleges and more than 130 special observers from the university.

2.6 Question Papers

Directorate of University Examinations conducted exams for the following courses.

- UG – B.Tech/ B.Pharm / MoU Courses / BBA - 2936
- PG – M.Tech/ MCA/ MBA/M.Pharm/ Pharm.D/ Pharm.D (PB) - 1758
- Pre. Ph.D - 30

For all the above courses 4724 question papers were received from the faculty serving at premier institutions like IITs, NITs and universities and the question papers received were moderated by the university subject experts.

After the results declaration, within one week the students can apply for recounting (RC)/revaluation (RV) through online, if the student is not satisfied with the acquired results. Around 10% of total students applied for RC/RV and the grade change observed is less than one percent for this academic year.

2.8 Challenge Valuation Analysis

Challenge Valuation (CV): After the re-valuation, if the student is not satisfied with the marks awarded, the university examination branch has given the opportunity to the student to apply for CV. In this process, two examiners will be appointed one is appointed by the university controller of examinations and the second examiner is nominated by the college, where student has studied the course. Also, the student parent will be present at the time challenging valuation. Initially they do independent valuation and then the discussion will be followed to finalize the marks by the student in that paper. Student will also be allowed to go through the answer script to see marks awarded and seek clarification if any, from the evaluators about his/her marks being awarded in that paper. A file consisting of marks awarded in challenge valuation will be submitted to the university officials for approval before publishing the result. This academic year 0.01% have applied for challenge valuation.

2.9 Student Services (Online Mode & Offline Mode)

After the completion of the course, the students are scattered all over the world for different purposes, the Directorate of University Examinations, JNTUH upgrades itself to meet the requirements of the students and also issue the certificates through online/offline services which will reach the students through by post or by hand within short time. For online services the applicants to apply online and to receive the following student services at their door steps with a few mouse clicks (<https://studentservices.jntuh.ac.in/os>). 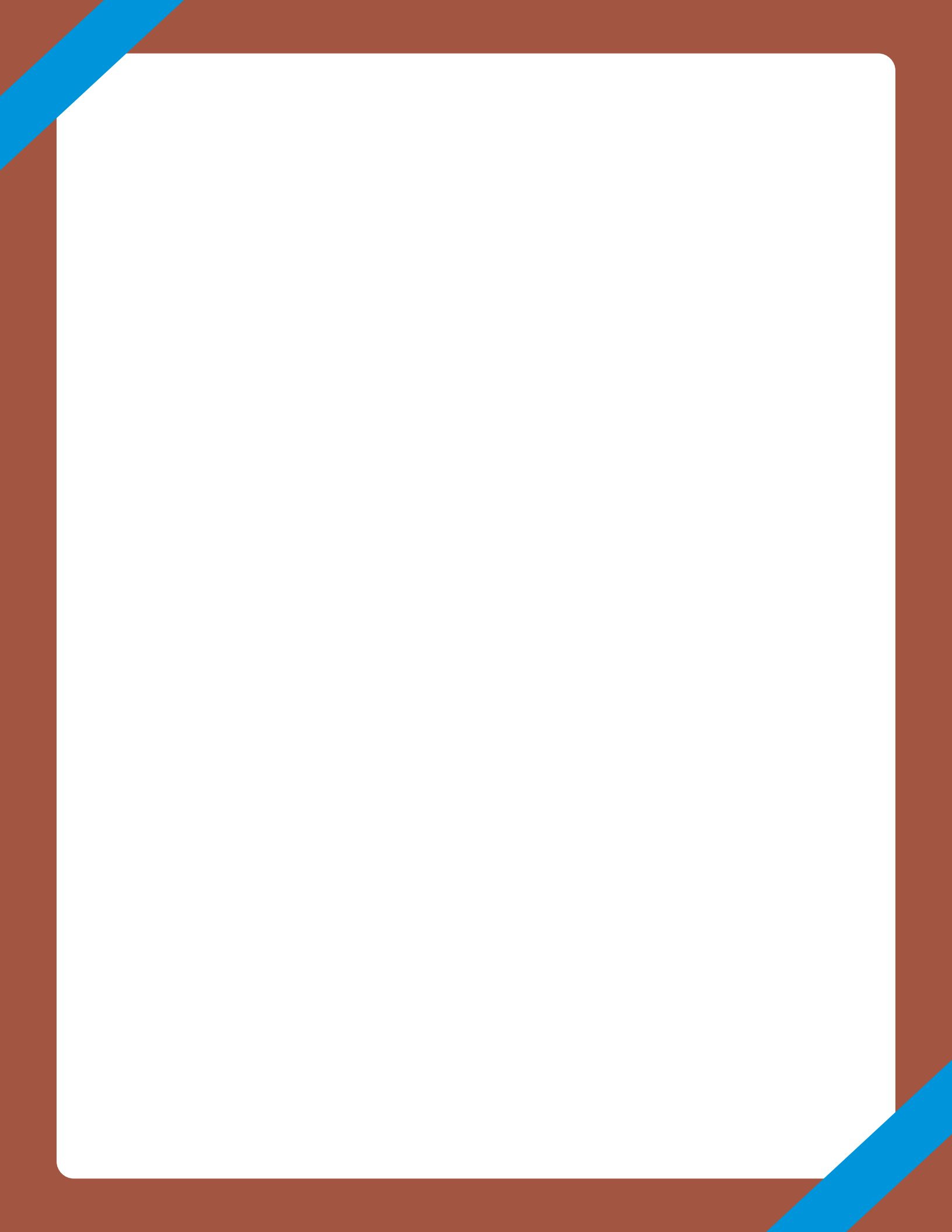
