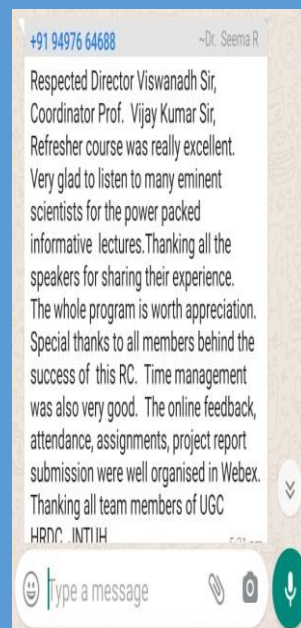
It was a wonderful experience. We could listen to many erudite lectures on various topics in relation to Indian Writing in English.
