### Smart India Hackathon 2025 Internal Hackathons

As a part of the Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2025, jointly promoted by Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (GoI), AICTE, New Delhi, Innovation Cell, MoE, JNTUH UCESTH held the Internal Hackathon. The event was coordinated by **Dr. E. Hemalatha**, Institute SPOC at UCESTH for SIH-2025 and **Dr. R. Sarath Babu.** The programme was facilitated by **Student Coordinators Sohail, Sanjana and Shlesha.** 



SIH 2025 has currently 212 Problem Statements open for Solutions from Student Innovators. The Internal Hackathon conducted at UCESTH was aimed at screening prospective Solutions to existing problem statements. A Total of 74 Teams participated in the Internal Hackathon with a total of 7 Evaluation Panels. The best Ideas identified will be chosen for further Report Compilation and Uploading on the SIH Web Portal. The list of Final Teams selected is for the SIH Grand Finale will be announced in October, 2025.

A total of 76 teams—456 students—presented solutions to the SIH's 212 nationwide problem statements, evaluated by eight expert jury panels.

To empower participants, an expert-led induction program was conducted. **Professors G. Vijaya Kumari, A. Kavitha** and E. Hemalatha addressed the teams, offering strategic guidance on preparing impactful project proposals and building effective prototypes for hackathon success. Their insights helped students refine their innovation process and enhanced the learning outcome of the event.





#### AlgoUniversity - JNTUH Hiring Tournament

Directorate of University Industry Interaction Centre (UIIC) at JNTUH in collaboration with IIIT Hyderabad startup AlgoUniversity conducted the 'AU Hiring Tournament' at JNTUH Campus. The Tournament has a unique 'Learn - Code - Get Hired' approach which enables placements for both Students and Working Professionals. Some of the top recruiters who hire through Hiring Tournaments include Amazon, Walmart, ADP, and EPAM. AlgoUniversity is a startup funded by reputed US based Venture Capitalist 'Y Combinator'.

The students register for the Hiring Tournament Online after which they are trained in Programming Concepts and immediately evaluated to gauge their understanding of concepts and coding skills. Mentors from companies like Google, Apple and Microsoft groom the students identified and connect them to prospective recruiters, with a high success of placement usually within a week's time. All Mentors are Alumni of IIIT Hyderabad who are employed in various segments of IT and IT Enabled Services Sector.

Vice-Chancellor, JNTUH, **Dr. T. Kishen Kumar Reddy** congratulated the Teams of AlgoUniversity and UIIC for this initiative and praised AlgoUniversity for this CSR activity to support the Student Community. The event was co-ordinated by **Dr. K. Anitha Sheela**, Director, UIIC, JNTUH with the encouragement, support and planning from Registrar, JNTUH, **Dr. K. Venkateshwara Rao.** 

3000 Engineering Graduates and also experienced Engineers took the Online Examination on 19.09.2025 of which 1000 members were shortlisted and invited for the AU Hiring Tournament. 277 of the 1000 members were from JNTUH Constituent Colleges. 89 of 219 Students belonging to the Constituent Colleges were shortlisted for interviews. 10 of 89 did not progress to the further interview Rounds. 56 of the remaining 79 are being considered for interview with Esoftlabs. All the 79 were also considered for interview with Interview.io.
