The topics chosen for the training includes Molecular Structure and Theories of Bonding, Water and its treatment, Electrochemistry and Corrosion, Stereochemistry, Reaction Mechanism and Synthesis of drug molecules and Spectroscopic techniques and applications.

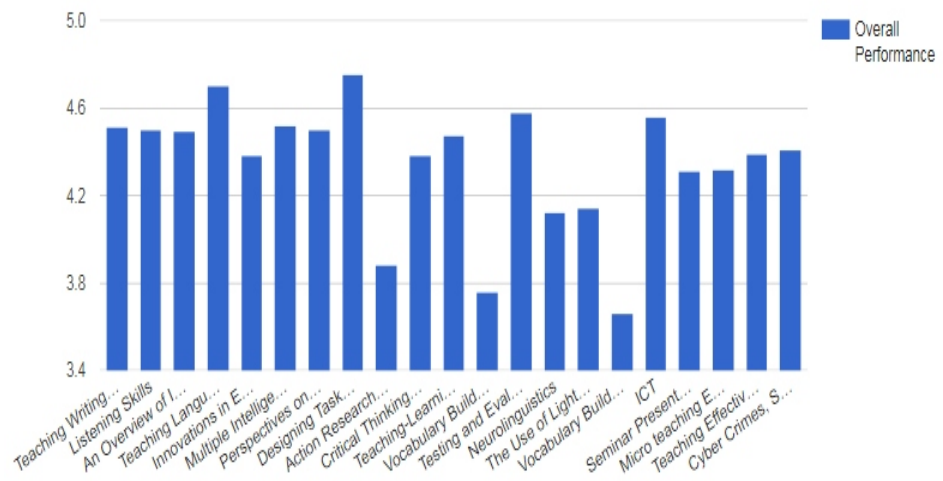
