TG PGECET-2026 results declared

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THE Telangana Post Graduate Engineering Common Entrance Test (TG PGECET-2026) results declared on Friday show strong performance across engineering streams. In Computer Science & IT, 8,367 candidates qualified out of 8,972 who appeared. In Electronics & Communication Engineering, 1,976 candidates qualified, while in Civil Engineering, 1,340 qualified. The pharmacy recorded one

of the highest participation levels, with 7,753 candidates qualifying.

TGCHC Chairman Prof V Balakista Reddy, JNTUH Vice-Chancellor Prof T Kishen Kumar Reddy and Rector Prof K Vijaya Kumar Reddy announced the results.

Gender-wise analysis indicates consistently high qualification percentages. Female candidates recorded a 94.31% qualification rate, while male candidates achieved 91.02%, reflecting strong performance across disciplines. Convener Dr K

Venkateswara Rao said a total of 26,077 candidates registered for the examination, held from May 29 to June 1 across 31 test centres—23 in Hyderabad and eight in Warangal. Of these, 23,637 candidates appeared, marking an impressive 90.64% attendance. The Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH) conducted the test on behalf of the Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHC). It served as the entrance exam for admissions to post-graduate courses.
