CM demands withdrawal of draft UGC regulations

Says changing guidelines invasion of state's rights

CHIEF Minister A Revanth Reddy on Sunday criticized the draft UGC guidelines, calling them as an "attack on the Constitution" and demanded immediate withdrawal by the Centre. He vowed to rally other states in the South for a collective fight against the proposed guidelines. Speaking after unveiling a statue of Dr BR Ambedkar at the BR Ambedkar Open University, Revanth Reddy alleged that the Centre is attempting to undermine the autonomy of state universities through the draft UGC amendments. He argued that Dr Ambedkar, the principal architect of the Constitution, had clearly outlined the subjects under state, Central, and concurrent lists, and accused the Centre of trying to infringe on state jurisdiction.

Centre trying to take over universities: Telangana CM

Revanth warns of protests if Centre does not withdraw the draft UGC regulations on selection of Vice-Chancellors; he says Centre's move to usurp States' powers is tantamount to a 'cultural attack'

Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to refrain from the proposed amendments to the University Grants Commission (UGC) regulations on the selection and appointment of Vice-Chancellors of universities, describing the move as an attack on the Constitution. He expressed concern that the Centre was trying to take over the powers to run universities from the States, and saw a conspiracy in the move. "The Centre's plan to take over the administration of universities may make them platforms for false propo-

ganda by a few individuals," he said. Various non-BJP State governments had opposed the draft regulations by the UGC on the selection of Vice-Chancellors to universities. The States contend that the regulations are in

violation of the federal principles of the Constitution. Unveiling a statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar on the B.R. Ambedkar Open University campus, Mr. Reddy said the proposed changes in UGC norms were tanta-

mount to a "cultural attack" on the States. It would lead to unnecessary controversies, he said.

Opposes privatisation. "The Centre's moves to usurp the States' powers will be seen as an attack on them. We are not prepared to lose our rights," he said, demanding that the Centre withdraw its move, failing which the State would stage protests if need be.

The Chief Minister said the States would be reduced to "tax collection organisations" if their powers were taken over by the Centre gradually. "Unfortunately, the country is witnessing a debate on the protection of the Constitution," he said, opposing the move to privatise varieties.

The Chief Minister said that the Centre was conspiring to privatise universities by changing the rules of UGC. "If the control of universities goes into the hands of the Centre, universities will become platforms for the poisonous propaganda," he explained. "I appeal to Prime Minister Narendra Modi from this platform. You desire to change the UGC regulations is an attack on the Constitution. This is a cultural attack on the States and such actions are not good for the Central government."

"This decision, being taken by Centre will lead to unnecessary controversies in campuses. We consider this decision as the Centre's encroachment on the powers of the states. We are not ready to give up our rights. The Centre must drop its decision to change the UGC regulations," the Chief Minister said.

"Our government is taking steps to curb the neglected education system. Vice-Chancellors have been appointed to strengthen universities in

line with the aspirations of the people of Telangana. But the Central government is trying to change the rules of UGC in the appointment of VCs, which in future could pose a major threat to the states." He also found fault with the Centre for not selecting prominent persons from Telangana for Padma awards and said he would write to the Prime Minister soon. Revanth sees a ploy in UGC rules amendment

Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy on Sunday alleged that there was a conspiracy to amend University Grants Commission (UGC) rules to remove the powers of states over universities, and he would lead a team of his counterparts from the southern states to submit a representation to Prime Minister Narendra Modi to protest the move.

He also expressed dissatisfaction at the Centre ignoring the names of Telangana personalities that the state government had proposed for the Padma honours. He was speaking after unveiling the statue of Dr B.R. Ambedkar at the Ambedkar Open University here on Republic Day.

Revanth Reddy said that it was unfortunate that there was a discussion on protecting the

Constitution again in the country. "Intellectuals must initiate a debate on the amendment of the Constitution. Late prime minister P.V. Narasimha Rao took the universities forward as a social responsibility. There is a need to protect universities by filling them proper staff to provide the best education to students," the Chief Minister said.
